

CUBS Dress Code

1. Shirts should be appropriate length. Halter, backless, large arm holes, low cut or midriff revealing tops are prohibited. Tank tops may be worn but straps must be as wide as two adult fingers.
2. Shorts and skirts should touch the child's fingertips when the child puts arms at their side.
3. Low-rise, baggy or sagging pants that reveal any skin or undergarments are prohibited. Loose fitting pants must be belted.
4. The wearing of apparel that has on it any writing, printing, symbols, or pictures that are judged by the building administrator to be immoral, lewd, vulgar, or is suggestive and/or implies sex, drugs, alcohol, violence, or other subjects disruptive to the normal operation of the school is prohibited.
5. Outerwear (coats, gloves, sock hats, etc.) are not to be worn in the classroom.
6. Unusual jewelry, chains and extreme hair color are prohibited.
7. Sunglasses and head covering, i.e. hoods and hats, are not to be worn in the building.
8. Tennis shoes and closed-toe shoes are encouraged. Please consider the student's activities when selecting shoes for the day. Flip-flops, slides, and shoes with rollers or wheels are not allowed.
9. Masks are an extension of the dress code. They cannot be offensive, scary, inappropriate, etc.
